### President Report to the AGM

During 2015 the Kooringal High P&C Committee provided financial support to enable a range of school and students representative activities. The P&C supported student representatives at:

- Tournament of Minds
- National Youth Science Forum
- o National AFL competition and international athletics competitions

The P&C provided additional funding for:

- o Maths text books over \$4000
- o PAV lighting \$4000
- Elevate HSC study skills program over \$4000

The P&C annual grants again supported the library, technology, sports uniforms, grounds, presentation night and the school band tutoring, to a total of \$28,500.

All this support was made possible by funds from the Canteen, and we are immensely grateful for the work of all the canteen volunteers, committee members and paid staff who make our canteen such a success. Every day, we depend on volunteers to turn up to serve our students, and we appreciate their hard work and commitment on behalf of our school and our students.

2015 saw some big changes affecting P&C. We said farewell to Gail Chyb after 20 years as Canteen Manager, and to Glyn Leyshon after 17 years as Principal. We welcomed Amanda Reid as our new Canteen Manager mid year and Kingsley Ireland as Principal (Relieving) for the last term. After years of solid P&C leadership by the former executive, new volunteers accepted the positions of president, secretary and treasurer.

The P&C held nine meetings through the year, each attended by the principal and an average of ten parents with two apologies. Meeting reminders were advertised on the KHS App and on the KHS Facebook page. Two meetings featured teacher presentations, on BYOD and on Learning Support. P&C members have also contributed to Kooringal High School as canteen volunteers, as parent representatives on staff interview panels, in BYOD and uniform policy discussions, at the Year 7 Orientation Night, at the Principal's farewell, and at Presentation Night. P&C members worked on the farewell functions for the Canteen Manager, and the building fund mail-out, to support plans for a Covered Outdoor Learning Area.

I want to thank all the P&C committee members over the past year for being involved, contributing their ideas and for attending our meetings. Our school needs to hear from parents and you are the parent voice.

I want to take this opportunity to thank three people in particular. Our 2015 treasurer, Jo-Anne Strader, has taken over the reins so capably and I appreciate her expertise in guiding our budgeting. Our 2015 canteen treasurer, Megan Foster has reliably managed day-to-day staff finances and I appreciate her expertise in employment matters. Our 2015 secretary Julie Bailey has stepped in with such good cheer and I appreciate her organisational expertise.
